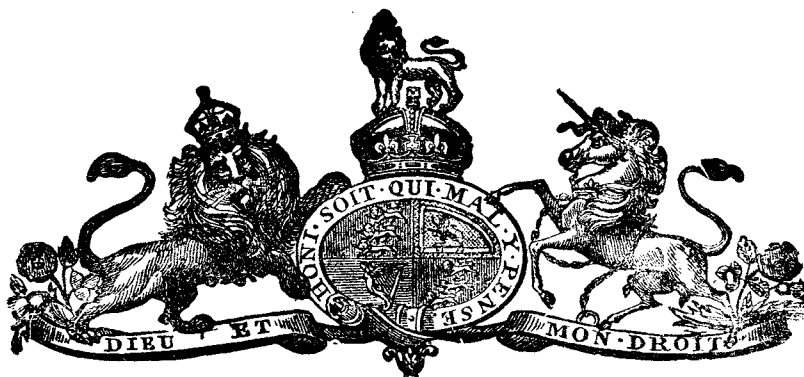

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Public Works, and for other purposes.
[4 November, 1926.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Public Works Execution Act Short title. (No. 4), 1926.”

2 In this Act “the schedule” means the schedule to this Act. Interpretation.

Public Works Execution (No. 4).

Minister may cause works specified in schedule to be carried out.

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 and 45 Vict. No. 31 to be applicable.

Land required may be acquired under 1 Geo. V. No. 11, at option of Minister.

Treasurer authorised to borrow £48,200.

3 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, executed, carried out, and completed the works specified in the schedule at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amount set forth in the schedule in respect thereof.

4 The provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880, and the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881, shall extend and apply to the works mentioned in the schedule as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

5 Notwithstanding anything contained in this or any other Act, any land required for the purpose of any public work specified in the schedule may, at the option of the Minister, be purchased, acquired, or taken under the Lands Resumption Act, 1910, and, in the event of such option being so exercised, the provisions of that Act shall accordingly apply, and be deemed to be incorporated with this Act, in lieu of the provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880, and the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881.

6 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to borrow, raise, and receive a total sum not exceeding Forty-eight thousand two hundred Pounds for the purposes of this Act.
