

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works Execution (Federal Aid Roads) Act, 1931.

## Public Works Execution (Federal Aid Roads).

#### A.D. 1931.

Amendment of 20 Geo. V. No. 62.

Section 6.

2 The Public Works Execution (Federal Aid Roads) Act (No. 2), 1929, is hereby amended—

- I. By expunging Subsection (1) of Section Six thereof and substituting therefor the following new Subsection (1):—
  - "(1) The cost of the said works shall be defrayed out of moneys provided, or to be provided, by the Commonwealth under the said agreement.":

Repeal of Section 7.

- II. By repealing Section Seven thereof: and
- III. As to the schedule thereto—
  - (a) By deleting the figures "19,097 18 9" and the total "£76,389 18 9" thereunder against the Item 1029 under the heading of "Reconstruction" on the last page thereof and substituting therefor, respectively, the figures "79,097 18 9" and "£136,389 18 9":
  - (b) By substituting the figures "136,389 18 9" for the figures "76,389 18 9" in the third line of the summary, and the figures "235,000" for the figures "175,000" in the total thereof: and
  - (c) By deleting all the words and figures after the lastmentioned total.

3-(1) The Public Works Execution (Federal Aid Roads) Act

(No. 1), 1929, is hereby repealed.

(2) All moneys paid and applied by the Treasurer under the authority of the said Act hereby repealed shall be repaid to the Treasurer out of the Federal Aid Roads Trust Fund, and shall be applied as Parliament shall hereafter provide.
