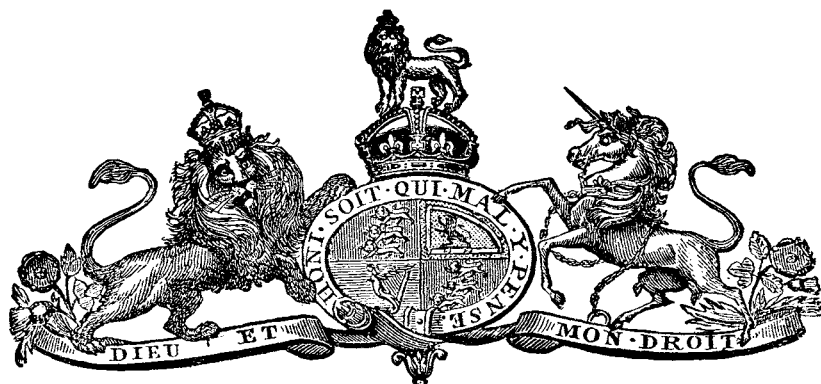

AN ACT to amend the Rabbits Destruction Act, 1889. [29 October, 1930.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Rabbits Destruction Act, 1930." Short title.

2—(1) The Rabbits Destruction Act, 1889, is hereby amended by deleting all the words from and including "and" in the eighth line down to and including the word "Launceston" in the tenth line of Section Thirty-three thereof. Amendment of

(2) The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have had effect as from the thirtieth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty.
