

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

- 1 The Governor in Council may from time to time, by Proclamation—Governor em-
 - (1.) Alter and re-define the boundaries of any District:
 - (2.) Assign to any District a new name in the place of the name boundaries of Districts, &c. theretofore assigned to such District:
 - (3.) Abolish any District.

2 When the boundaries of any District are altered, the District as District as realtered shall be deemed to be substituted for the District so altered, and defined to be subthe Trustees of the District before it was altered shall be the Trustees of stituted for former District. the District as altered.

3 The assigning of a new name to any District shall not affect the Assigning new powers of the Trustees, or any other matter relating to such District.

4 This Act and the said Act and every Act amending the same shall, Acts to be read save as amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act. together.
