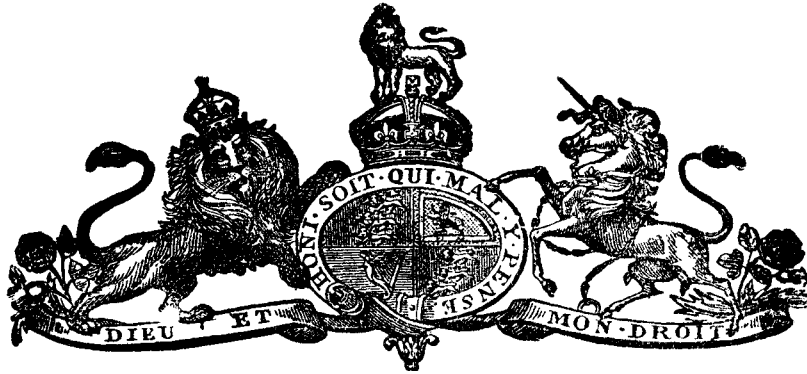

AN ACT to amend the Rural Districts Elec- <sup>A.D.</sup> 1929.  
trical Undertakings Act, 1928.

[24 December, 1929.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as “The Rural Districts Electrical Undertakings Act, 1929.” Short title.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and thirty. Commencement.

**2** Section Two of the Rural Districts Electrical Undertakings Act, 1928 (hereinafter called the Principal Act), is hereby amended by inserting after the word "Evandale" in the definition of "The Corporation" the words "or of Bothwell, Esperance, Huon, Kentish, Kingborough, Leven, or Penguin."

**3**—(1) The provisions of Sections Four and Five of the Principal Act shall not apply to, or in respect of, any of the loans specified in the schedule to this Act.

(2) Section Two of the Principal Act shall apply to the several Acts enumerated in the schedule to this Act as if the same were included in the schedule to the Principal Act.

Transfer of loans.

**4** Upon the Chief Engineer and General Manager of the Department certifying to the Treasurer that the undertaking of a Corporation has been taken over as provided by this Act—

- i. The amount of each sinking fund in respect of the several loans raised for the purposes of the Lighting Acts of such Corporation as set forth in the schedule to this Act shall be applied by the Treasurer as at the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, for or towards the redemption of the loan for which the same was established :
- ii. The balance of every such loan as aforesaid, after the application of such sinking fund as hereinbefore provided, shall be transferred and debited to an account to be opened in the books of the Treasury for the purposes of this Act :
- iii. Upon any such transfer as aforesaid, all obligation and liability of the Corporation to the Treasurer in respect of the loan so transferred shall cease and determine, and the Corporation shall be responsible only for such contributions as may be provided by its agreement :
- iv. It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate and apply for the purposes of this Act all or any of the several amounts authorised to be raised under the Lighting Acts specified in the schedule to this Act, less any amounts reappropriated thereout by any previous Act, and all moneys reappropriated under this section shall be credited to the account mentioned in Paragraph ii. hereof :
- v. The Minister may apply any moneys reappropriated as aforesaid under this Act for or towards the purposes of the Country Districts Branch of the Department.

**5** The Treasurer may make such entries and adjustments from time to time in his books as he may deem necessary for giving effect to the provisions of Section Four hereof.
