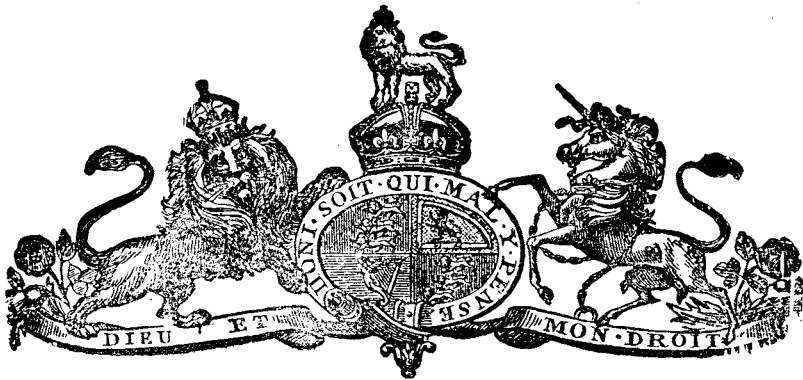

AN ACT to amend "The Railway Management Act, 1910." A.D. 1924.
[18 March, 1924.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Railway Management Act, Short title, 1924."

2 In this Act "The Act of 1910" means "The Railway Management Act, 1910." Interpretation.

3 Wherever the word "Four" occurs in any of the Sections Nine, Ten, and Thirteen of the Act of 1910 the word "Five" is hereby substituted therefor. Substitution of

4 Section Twelve of the Act of 1910 is hereby amended by deleting the words "One thousand five hundred" in the First and Second lines thereof, and substituting the words "Two thousand" therefor. Amendment of
