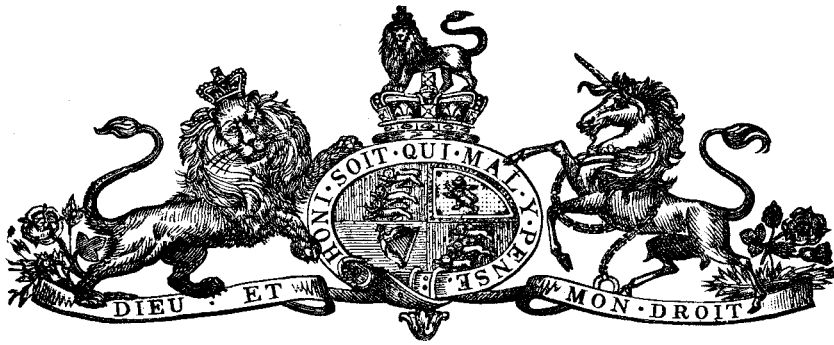

AN ACT to amend the Law relating to the Registration of Births and Deaths in *Tasmania*. [28 November, 1890.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Law at present in force providing for the Registration of Births and Deaths in *Tasmania* :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as " The Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1890." Short title.

2 In this Act the expression " the said Act " shall mean and include the Act of Council of the 2nd *Victoria*, No. 8, and every Act amending the same. Interpretation.

3 Any person required by the said Act to give information concerning a birth or death who, in the opinion of any Registrar or Deputy Registrar, may be unable to comply with the conditions of the said Act because of great distance from or some other difficulty in making personal communication with the Registrar or Deputy Registrar of the District, may make a Declaration in writing according to the form in the Schedule (1.) or (2.), as the case may be, or to the like effect, in the presence of any Registrar, Deputy Registrar, Justice of the Peace, Police Officer, or any other person specially authorised by the Registrar-General, and the Extra facilities for informants situated at inconvenient distances from Registrar.

Registration of Births and Deaths.

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aforesaid persons before whom such Declaration shall have been made shall attest the same, and the informant shall forthwith post the said Declaration to the Registrar or Deputy Registrar of the District in which the birth or death occurred, and the last-mentioned Registrar or Deputy Registrar shall retain the same, and shall in the prescribed manner enter the birth or death, as the case may be, in the Register, inserting the words "According to information contained in the declaration of _____"; and the entry so made shall be deemed for the purpose of the said Act to have been signed by the person who signed the Declaration.

Letters or packets
free of postage.

4 All letters or packets containing any Declaration under this Act transmitted by post within the Colony to or from any Registrar or Deputy Registrar of Births and Deaths, if marked on the outside with the words "Declaration under 'The Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1890,'" shall be delivered free of postage.

Acts to be read
together.

5 This Act and the said Act, save as amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act.
