

ANALYSIS.

- 1. Short title.

AN ACT to provide for the Reinstatement 1917.
of certain Persons as Purchasers of certain
Crown Lands, and for other purposes.
[21 December, 1917.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Reinstatement of Crown Lands Short title, Purchasers Act, 1917,"

Certain persons whose lands have been forfeited may be reinstated as purchasers. Schedule (1).

Certain persons named in Schedule (2) to be permitted to complete their purchases.

2 The Commissioner of Crown Lands may, with the consent of the Governor, reinstate the persons named in Schedule (1) hereto as purchasers of the several lots or areas of land set opposite to their names, under the provisions of the Acts regulating the sale or disposition of Crown lands under which the purchases of such lots or areas were respectively made; and thereupon such persons shall be liable to pay all instalments upon such lands at the date of forfeiture, and all instalments thereafter due thereon, together with the amount of fines and charges for the cost of advertising, as provided in Section Ninetysix of "The Crown Lands Act, 1911," together with interest at the rate of Five Pounds per centum per annum from the date when such instalments became due.

3 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any repealed or existing Act regulating the sale or disposition of lands of the Crown, it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to permit the persons named in Schedule (2) hereto to complete the purchase of the several areas of land set opposite to their names; and upon payment of the balance of purchase-money into the Treasury, together with a grant fee of Fifteen Shillings, the Governor is hereby authorised, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty the King, to convey and alienate the said lands to the said persons respectively, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.

Commissioner may sell certain land to Latrobe Turf Club Trustees.

4 Upon the persons in whom the lease of the racecourse described in Schedule (3) hereto is vested duly surrendering to His Majesty the King such lease free from encumbrances, it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to sell by private contract to such persons as the Latrobe Turf Club shall nominate as trustees of the racecourse the said land described in Schedule (3) hereto in fee simple for the sum of One hundred and twenty Pounds, upon the terms and conditions set forth in Sections Seventy-seven and Eightythree of "The Crown Lands Act, 1911," and the grant to be issued in respect of the said land shall provide that such land shall be used as a public racecourse and for no other purpose, and that the grant shall be revoked if this condition be broken.

Power to exchange certain land in the vicinity of Great Lake with Eustace Noel Cameron. and 7).

Commissioner may sell certain land to Th mas Parker. Schedule (8).

5 Upon Eustace Noel Cameron surrendering to His Majesty the King the fee simple, free from all encumbrances, of the land described in Schedules (4), (5), and (6) hereto, it shall be lawful for the Governor in the name and on behalf of His Majesty the King, to convey and alienate the land described in Schedule (7) hereto to the said Eustace Noel Cameron in fee simple, under and subject to the provisions of Schedules (4, 5, 6, "The Crown Lands Act, 1911."

> 6 It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to sell by private contract to Thomas Parker, the surface of the lot of Crown land described in Schedule (8) for the sum of Ten Pounds, upon the terms applicable to the sale of Town lands under the provisions of Part IX. of "The Crown Lands Act, 1911."

7 It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Crown Lands to sell A.D. 1917. by private contract to Ellen McNamara the lot of Crown land described in Schedule (9) hereto for the sum of Two Pounds; and upon payment of such sum of money into the Treasury, together with a grant fee of Fifteen Shillings, the Governor is hereby authorised, in McNamara. the name and on behalf of His Majesty the King, to convey and Schedule (9). alienate the said land to the said Ellen McNamara, in fee simple, or for any less estate or interest.

Fourteen years the islands described in Schedule (11) hereto to the Schedule (11). persons named in the said schedule, at the rental therein set forth.

The leases for such islands shall be subject to the provisions of "The Crown Lands Act, 1911," applicable to leases for grazing purposes, and any regulations made thereunder with regard to leasing Crown lands for grazing purposes.
