

AN ACT to amend The Rural Police Rate Act. $[20 \; February, \; 1867.]$

WHEREAS it is expedient to enable the Governor in Council to PREAMBLE. raise and levy a Rural Police Rate, not exceeding the sum of One Shilling in the Pound, on the Annual Value of Property in such parts of the Colony as are not Municipalities: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Rate Act shall apply to such increased Rate.

- 2 This Act and The Rural Police Rate Act, except in so far as the Acts to be read same is altered by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one together. and the same Act.
- 3 In referring to this Act it shall be sufficient to use the expression Short title. The Rural Police Rate Act, No. 2.
