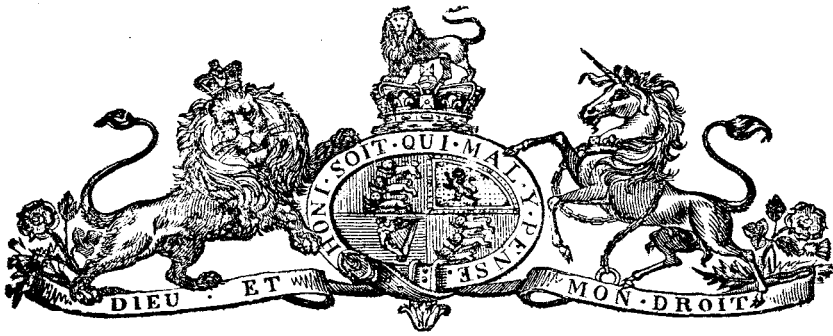

AN ACT to further amend *The Rural Police Rate Act*. A.D. 1881.
[8 November, 1881.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend *The Rural Police Rate Act*: PREAMBLE.
21 Vict. No. 35

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The terms "Valuation Roll," "Police District," and "District" used in *The Rural Police Rate Act* and in this Act shall, on and after the First day of *April*, 1882, have the meanings hereinafter assigned to them— "Valuation Roll" "Police District," and "District" defined.

"Valuation Roll" shall mean and include every Assessment Roll made by the Commissioners, or either of them, under "The Real and Personal Estates Duties Act": 43 Vict. No. 12.

"Police District" and "District" shall mean every District, except the City of *Hobart* the Town of *Launceston* and every Rural Municipality, for which an Assessment Roll has been made by the said Commissioners or either of them.

2 Notwithstanding anything contained in *The Rural Police Rate Act*, the Rural Police Rate shall, in the year 1882, be payable on the First day of *April*, and on the like day in every succeeding year, and shall be the sum of Ninepence in the Pound upon the annual value of property in every District as shown by the Assessment Rolls hereinbefore mentioned. Date of payment and amount of Rural Police Rate.

Nothing herein contained shall affect the collection and recovery of the Rural Police Rate made by the Governor in Council in the year 1881.

3 The Rural Police Rate shall, in the year 1882 and in every subsequent year, be payable and paid to the Commissioners appointed under "The Real and Personal Estates Duties Act," who are hereby appointed Collectors of such Rate for such Districts respectively as the Governor may determine; and all the provisions contained in the said Act relating to Collectors of the said Rate and the recovery thereof shall apply to the said Commissioners and the Rate made payable by this Act to and for all intents and purposes whatsoever, save that it shall not be lawful for the Governor to pay any Salaries or Allowances to the said Commissioners as Collectors of the Rural Police Rate.

Acts to be read
together.

4 This Act and *The Rural Police Rate Act*, and every Act altering or amending the same, except in so far as the same may be altered by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act.

Short Title.

5 This Act may be cited as "The Rural Police Rate Act, No. 5."
