AN ACT to further amend The Rural Police A.D. 1883. [29 October, 1883.] Rate Act.

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend The Rural Police PREAMBLE. 21 Vict. No. 35.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Rural Police Rate shall be payable on the First day of April Date of payment in the year 1884 and on the like day in every succeeding year, and and amount of shall be the sum of Ninepence in the Pound upon the annual value of property in every District as shown by the Valuation Rolls mentioned in The Rural Police Rate Act.

2 The Rural Police Rate for the years 1882 and 1883 shall be Rate for 1882 and deemed to have been payable, and shall be paid, upon the annual value 1883 how of property in every District as shown by the Valuation Rolls mentioned payable. in the said Act.

Collectors under 43 Vict. No. 12 to be Collectors of Rural Police Rate. 4 The Rural Police Rate shall be payable and paid to the Collectors appointed under "The Real and Personal Estates Duties Act," who are hereby appointed Collectors of such Rate for such Districts respectively as the Governor may determine; and all the provisions contained in the said last-mentioned Act relating to the recovery of the Duty under Schedule (A.) of that Act shall apply to the recovery of the Rural Police Rate to and for all intents and purposes whatsoever.

Rate may be transmitted by Money Order.

5 The amount of Rural Police Rate or Land Duty payable by any person may be transmitted to the Collector by Money Order, which shall be issued free of poundage by every officer of the Post Office charged with the duty of issuing Money Orders; and all the provisions contained in the Fifth Section of the Act to facilitate the collection and recovery of Rates, and the Fifty-sixth Section of "The Real and Personal Estates Duties Act, 1880," shall extend and apply to any letter or packet containing any such Money Order.

Occupiers of Crown Land to pay half rate. 6 The occupiers of Crown Land under lease or licence shall be liable to pay only one-half of the Rural Police Rate in respect of the Crown Land occupied by them; and no such Rate or any proportion thereof shall be payable by the Crown, whether as proprietor or otherwise.

Repeal. 45 Vict. No. 19. 7 "The Rural Police Rate Act, No. 5," is hereby repealed, provided that this repeal shall not affect the recovery of any amount of Rural Police Rate payable when this Act takes effect.

Acts to be read together.

8 The Rural Police Rate Act and every Act altering or amending the same, except in so far as the same may be altered by this Act, and this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act.

Short title.

9 This Act may be cited as "The Rural Police Rate Act, No. 6."
