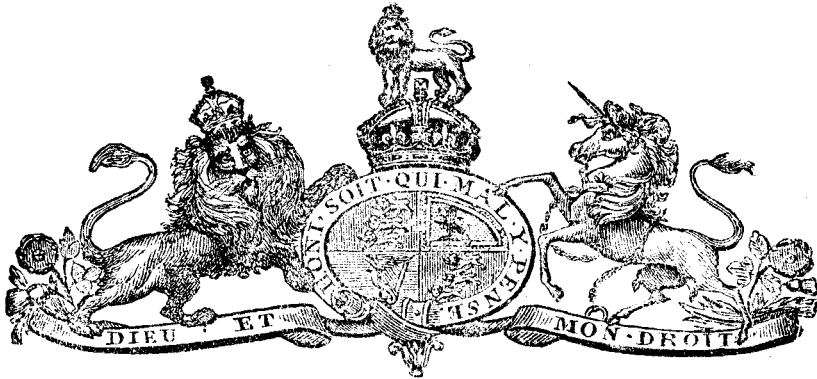

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title.
2. Power to Minister to undertake works.
3. Power to Treasurer to reappropriate £23,750.

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of A.D.
 certain Works in connection with the State **1932.**
 Railways. [22 November, 1932.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Railway Works Execution Short title. Act, 1932.”

2 The Minister may cause the works specified in Schedules (1) and (2) to be undertaken and executed at a cost not exceeding in each case the amount specified in the schedule in respect of each work.

3 The Treasurer may reappropriate the sums specified in Schedule (3), being the unexpended balances of the amounts appropriated for the items set forth in that schedule, and apply the aggregate thereof, amounting to the sum of Twenty-three thousand seven hundred and fifty Pounds, in defraying the cost of the works authorised by this Act.
