

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Railway Works Execution Short title. Act, 1933."
- 2 The Minister may cause the works specified in Schedules Power to (1) and (2) to be undertaken and executed at a cost not exceed. Minister to ing in each case the amount specified in the schedule in respect undertake works. thereof.

Power to Treasurer to reappropriate £2215. 3 The Treasurer may reappropriate the sums specified in Schedule (3), being the unexpended balances of the amounts appropriated for the items set forth in that schedule, and apply the aggregate thereof, amounting to the sum of Two thousand two hundred and fifteen Pounds, in defraying the cost of the works authorised by this Act.
