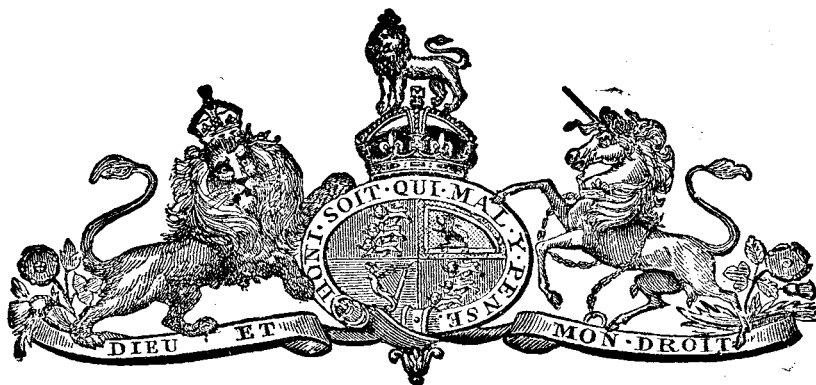

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of ^{A.D.} 1923.
certain State Railway Works, and for other
purposes. [12 April, 1923.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Railway Works Execution Act (No. 2), 1923." Short title.

2 In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires— Interpretation.
"Minister" means the Minister for Railways for the time being.

Act retrospective.

3—(1) It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend, in, and in connection with, the purchase and acquisition of the land described in Item Seventeen in the schedule to "The Railway Works Execution Act, 1919," the sum of One hundred and seventy-one Pounds Six Shillings and Twopence, in addition to the sum of Two hundred Pounds voted for that purpose by the lastmentioned Act.

(2) The said sum of One hundred and seventy-one Pounds Six Shillings and Twopence shall be expended out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.

4 The provisions of this Act shall have a retrospective operation.
