

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# AN ACT to further amend "The Stock Act." A.D. 1896. [13 November, 1896.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 This Act may be cited as "The Stock Act, 1896."

Short title.

2 Sections Three, Nine, Ten, and Schedule (1.) of "The Stock Repeal. 53 Vict. No. 43. Act, 1889," are hereby repealed.

3—(1.) Every sheepowner, except where he has obtained a clean Sheep to be certificate as hereinafter provided, shall dip all sheep in his possession dipped. after shearing in every year, and shall also at the same time dip all lambs in his possession.

(2.) In this Section the expression "after shearing" shall mean any time between the First day of August in any year and the First day

of April in any succeeding year.

(3.) "Dipped" or "dip" means thoroughly immersed in some

effective tick-destroying preparation.

Any Sheepowner who refuses to satisfy the Inspector that the said sheep have been dipped shall be liable to a penalty of not more than Five Pounds nor less than One Pound.

4 Any Sheepowner may, on payment of all necessary expenses Sheepowner may to be incurred for the purpose, at any time apply to an Inspector for a obtain clean certificate of cleanness, and thereupon such sheep shall be examined by certificate.

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an Inspector, who shall, if satisfied that the said sheep are thoroughly clean, grant a certificate of cleanness in the form in the Schedule (2.) hereto, and upon receiving such certificate it shall not be compulsory for such Sheepowner to dip his sheep.

Owner to make Return of sheep dipped.

5 Every Sheepowner shall, within One month after he has dipped his sheep as aforesaid, make a Return to the Chief Inspector in the form in Schedule (1.); and any Sheepowner refusing or wilfully neglecting to make such Return shall forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding Two Pounds.

Every person who wilfully makes any false Return under this Act shall forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding Five Pounds.

Transfer of money from Stock Fund to Consolidated Revenue. 6 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to transfer to the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony the balance standing to the credit of "The Stock Act Fund" on the Thirty-first day of *December*, 1894, and all sums since received on account of the said Fund.

Appropriation of moneys payable to Stock Fund.

7 All sums of money appropriated under the provisions of any Act of Parliament for and towards the purposes of "The Stock Act Fund" shall be paid and payable in and towards the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

Acts to be read together.

8 This Act and "The Stock Act" and every Act amending the same, save as amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.

Commencement of Act.

9 This Act shall come into force and take effect on and after the Thirty-first day of *March*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven.
