

AN ACT to amend the Stock Act, 1932. [1933.] [1933.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Stock Act, 1933."

- 2 Section Fifteen of the Principal Act is hereby amended by expunging Subsections (5) and (6) thereof and by inserting after Subsection (4) thereof the following new Subsections (5), (6), and (7):—
- "(5) Exemption from the provisions of this section may be granted as prescribed in respect of any stud sheep which are found on inspection not to be infected.
- "(6) An inspector, upon being satisfied that any sheep are free from infection, may exempt such sheep from the provisions of this section until the end of the current dipping season.
- "(7) An application for exemption under this section shall be made to the Chief Inspector not later than the first day of December in any year, and the owner shall pay such costs of inspection as may be prescribed."

Amendment to be retrospective.

3 The amendment effected by Section Two hereof shall be deemed to have had effect as from the commencement of the Principal Act.
