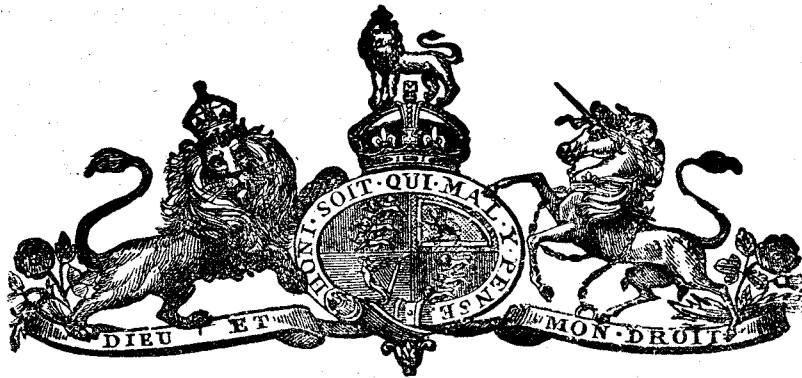

**2** The sum of One hundred and forty-four thousand seven hundred and fourteen Pounds Two Shillings and Eleven Pence, which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue of the State of Tasmania for the service of the year ended the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty, for the several purposes specified in the schedule to this Act shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of "The Appropriation Act, 1919-20," for the purposes and services expressed in the schedule to this Act.
