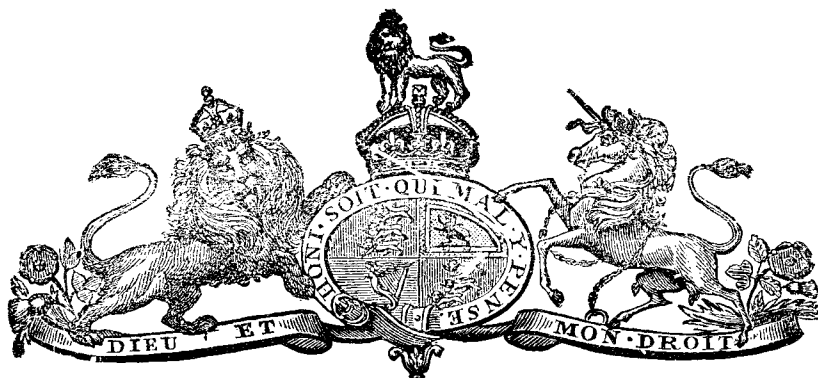

 AN ACT to amend the State Advances Act, 1907. A.D. 1930.
[23 December, 1930.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as “The State Advances Act, 1930.” Short title.
- 2 The State Advances Act, 1907, is hereby amended— Amendment of
 - I. By expunging Paragraph III. of Section Forty-three (inserted by the State Advances Act, 1928), and substituting therefor the following new Paragraph III.:— 7 Ed. VII.
