

AN ACT to further amend "The Scab Act, A.D. 1874. 1870." [18 September, 1874.]

WHEREAS it is necessary to further amend "The Scab Act, 1870:" PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, 33 Vict. No. 2. by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 In all legal proceedings taken against any person for any breach of or non-compliance with the provisions of "The Scab Act, 1870," or any upon defendant. Act altering or amending the same, the onus of proving that such person was duly licensed, or was otherwise exempted from the operation of any penalty imposed by the said Acts. shall, in all such cases, rest upon the defendant.
- 2 In all such proceedings the defendant shall be competent to give Defendant comevidence, anything contained in any law or practice to the contrary petent to give notwithstanding.
- 3 This Act and "The Scab Act, 1870," and every Act altering or Acts to be read amending the same, shall, save so far as the same may be altered or together. amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act.
- 4 This Act may be cited as "The Scab Act Amendment Act, Short title. No. 5."
