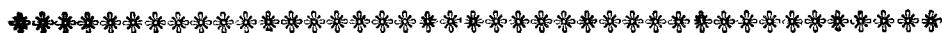

AN ACT to further amend *The Sorell Causeway Act* [22 October, 1869.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend *The Sorell Causeway Act*: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PREAMBLE.
24 Vict. No. 27.

1 For the purpose of constructing and completing the Causeway and Works referred to in *The Sorell Causeway Act* the Trustees are hereby empowered to purchase and take, in the mode prescribed by *The Lands Clauses Act*, such land as they deem necessary for the said Works and the approaches thereto; and, subject to the provisions of this Act, *The Lands Clauses Act* shall be incorporated with *The Sorell Causeway Act*; and for the purposes of such incorporation the Trustees shall be deemed to be the Promoters of the undertaking; and the compensation shall be estimated and the land may be taken as if the same were required for a Bye-road.

Trustees may purchase and take land.

2 This Act, and *The Sorell Causeway Act*, and *The Sorell Causeway Act, No. 2*, and the Act 29 *Victoria*, No. 27, shall, save as altered or amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act.

Acts to be read together.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Sorell Causeway Act, No. 3."
