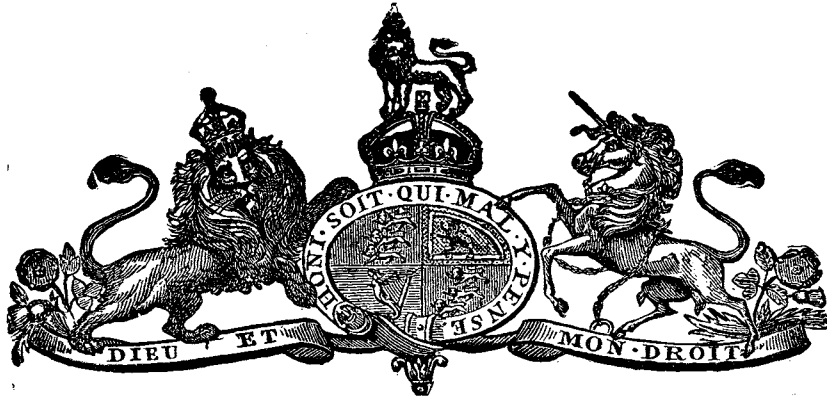

AN ACT to amend the Stamp Duties Act, <sup>A.D.</sup> 1882. [14 November, 1927.] 1927.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Stamp Duties Act, 1927.” Short title.

2 The Stamp Duties Amendment Act, 1904, as amended by the Stamp Duties Amendment Act, 1917, is hereby amended by deleting from Schedule (2) thereto the words “at a rate not exceeding One hundred and seventy-five Pounds per annum” occurring in the penultimate paragraph of the list of exemptions from duty on receipts.
