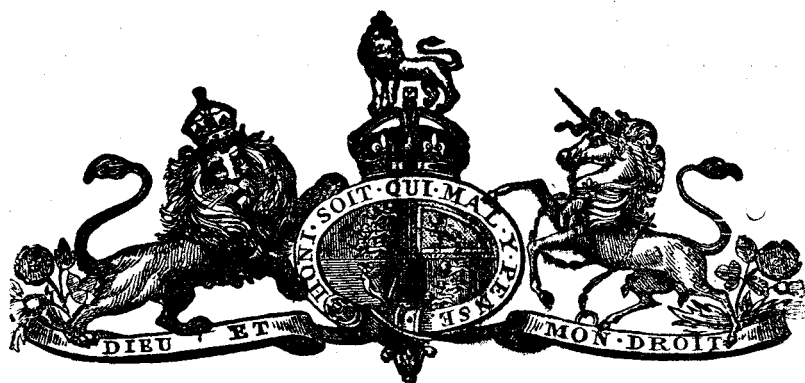

2. Securities for advances to buy bonds in Commonwealth War Loan (No. 7) exempt from Stamp Duties.

AN ACT to further amend "The Stamp Duties Act, 1882," and for other purposes. A.D. 1918.  
[23 December, 1918.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

### 1 This Act—

- i. May be cited as "The Stamp Duties Amendment Act, 1918," and
- ii. Is hereby incorporated and shall be read and construed as one with "The Stamp Duties Act, 1882," and its amendments.

**2—**(1) Every equitable mortgage or other instrument made as or purporting to be a security for the payment of money advanced or lent or to be advanced or lent for the purpose of taking up or completing the purchase of any bonds or stock in the Commonwealth War Loan (No. 7), or in any future Commonwealth War Loan, shall be exempt from the payment of Stamp Duties.

(2) The provisions of this Section shall have a retrospective effect.
