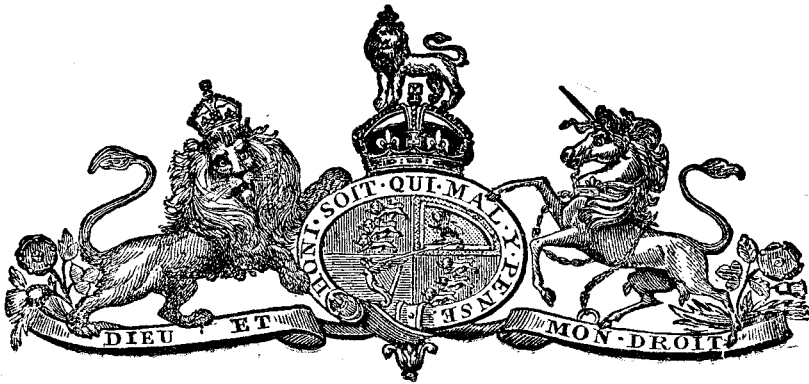

AN ACT to amend the State Highways Maintenance Act, 1929.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The State Highways Maintenance Act, 1930." Short title.

2 The State Highways Maintenance Act, 1929, is hereby amended—

I. By inserting after Subsection (1) of Section Five thereof the following new Subsection (1A):—

“(1A) Upon the Council of any of the Municipalities of Bruny, Flinders, or King Island respectively satisfying the Minister that such council, within the immediately preceding financial year, has expended upon the roads of its municipality a sum not less than the total amount of motor taxes collected in such municipality in such year, the Minister shall pay to such council out of the fund an amount equal to such total:”

II. By deleting the words “such footway shall be maintained by such corporation and” in the third and fourth lines of Section Ten thereof, and by adding at the end of that section the words “and the remainder of such State Highway within such town or village shall be maintained by such corporation.”

Reference to a main road to be construed as a reference to a road which is a State highway.

3 Where in any Act reference is made to a main road, it shall be construed as a reference to a road which is a State highway within the meaning of the State Highways Maintenance Act, 1929.

4 The Main Roads Maintenance Act, 1928, is hereby repealed.
