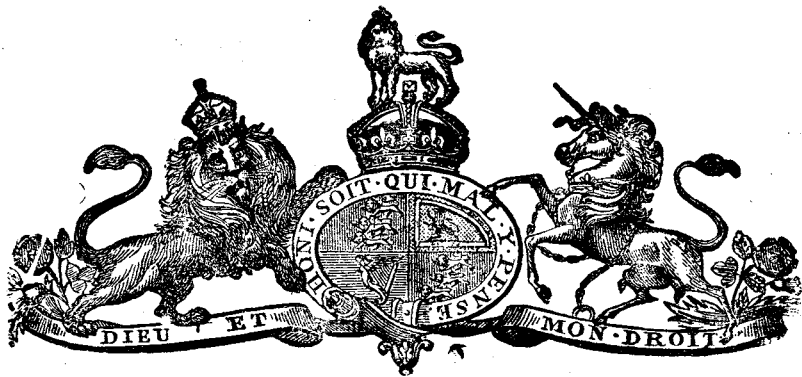

AN ACT to validate proceedings of the <sup>A.D.</sup> **1918.**  
Trustees of the Smithton Harbour Trust  
on and since the Twenty-third day of  
December, One thousand nine hundred  
and fourteen. [22 November, 1918.]

**W**HEREAS under and by virtue of "The Smithton Harbour PREAMBLE.  
Trust Act, 1913," By-laws were duly made and published :

And whereas Standing Order No. 3 of By-law No. 1 directed that  
all meetings of the Trustees shall be held at 2:30 p.m. on the last  
Wednesday in each month :

And whereas on the Twenty-third day of December, One thousand  
nine hundred and fourteen, without having altered or amended the  
said By-law, the Trustees changed the time of meeting of the Trustees  
from 2:30 p.m. to 8 p.m. on the last Wednesday in each month :

And whereas doubts having arisen as to the legality of the proceedings of the said Trustees at such meetings held at the wrong hour :

Be it therefor enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

Short title and  
incorporation.

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Smithton Harbour Trust Proceedings Validating Act, 1918,” and shall be incorporated with and read as one with “The Smithton Harbour Trust Act, 1913.”

Validating of pro-

**2** Notwithstanding the irregularity set out in the preamble to this Act, all proceedings at all meetings of the Smithton Harbour Trustees held on and since the Twenty-third day of December, One thousand nine hundred and fourteen, are hereby validated, and all appointments of officers made to the Trust, requisitions, records, notifications, resignations of officers, instruments, and generally all acts of authority, collections and disbursements of funds, which originated or were carried out at such meeting or meetings, shall have the same force and effect as if the same had been duly made, passed, and carried out at a meeting or meetings duly convened and held at the proper hour of meeting of the said Trustees.
