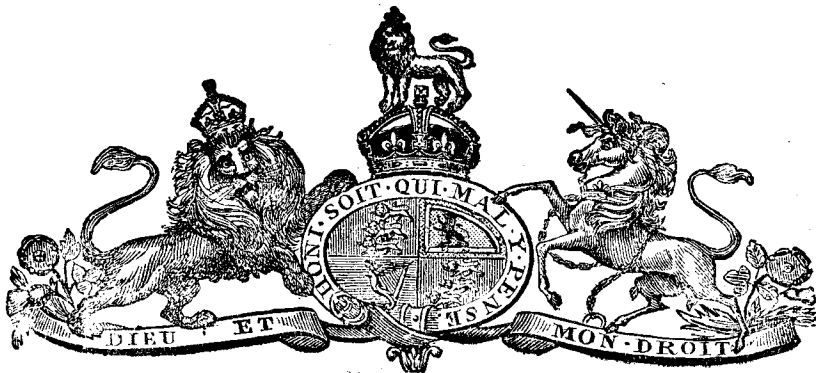

AN ACT to amend "The St. Marys, Avoca, and Cornwall Water Act, 1910." ^{A.D.} 1911.
[10 January, 1912.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend "The St. Marys, Avoca, and Cornwall Water Act, 1910" (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act), by increasing the amount which may be lawfully borrowed by the Municipal Council of Fingal for the purpose of supplying water to the town of Cornwall: PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

3 Section Nineteen of the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting from the Third line thereof the word "Two," and substituting therefor the word "Three."
