AN ACT to appropriate certain Sums for A.D. 1887. and towards Public Works, and to provide for the Erection and Construction thereof. [20 December, 1887.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and PREAMBLE. with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :----

1 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines— "The Minister" means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him, or acting under his orders.

2 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause the several Works Minister to cause mentioned in the First and Second Parts of the Schedule to be con-structed, completed or improved at a cost for each separate Work not structed, completed, or improved, at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amount therein set opposite such Work.

3 The cost of the several Works specified in the Schedule shall be Defrayment of defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that cost of Works. purpose.

4 All powers by this Act conferred upon the Minister may be Powers may be exercised by him or by any person acting under his written authority in that behalf, anything contained in the Fifty-second Section of "The thing in Sect. 52 of 48 Vict. No. 28 Roads Act, 1884," to the contrary notwithstanding.

Supplementary Public Works.

Provisions of 45 Vict. No. 31 to be applicable.

Appropriation of money voted by 49 Vict. No. 43. **5** All the provisions contained in "The Branch Roads and Bridges Construction Act, 1881," and "The Roads Maintenance Act, 1881," shall extend and apply to the construction, completion, and improvement of the several Branch Roads and Bridges mentioned in the First Part of the Schedule to this Act, as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

6 The sum of Three thousand Pounds, appropriated by "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1885," for and towards "Additions to Railway Bridges over River *Derwent* to adapt same for Road Traffic," (Item 120), shall and may be equally applied for and towards the construction, completion, or improvement of the Works numbered Two and Four respectively in the said Schedule.
