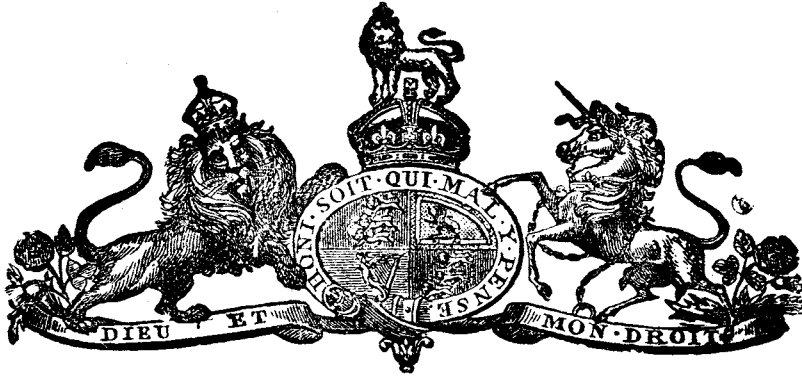

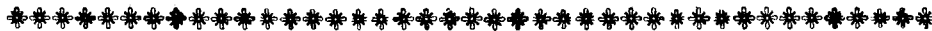

AN ACT to authorise and provide for the A.D. 1929.
 Payment out of the Consolidated Revenue
 of certain Expenses incurred in relation to
 the Performance of Services for the State.

[25 July, 1929.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Special Services Authorisation Act, 1929.” Short title.

2 There shall be payable and paid by the Treasurer to the several persons named in the schedule to this Act the several amounts and for the several purposes set opposite their names respectively in the said schedule.

Appropriation.

3 All moneys payable under this Act shall be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue, which to the necessary extent is hereby appropriated accordingly.
