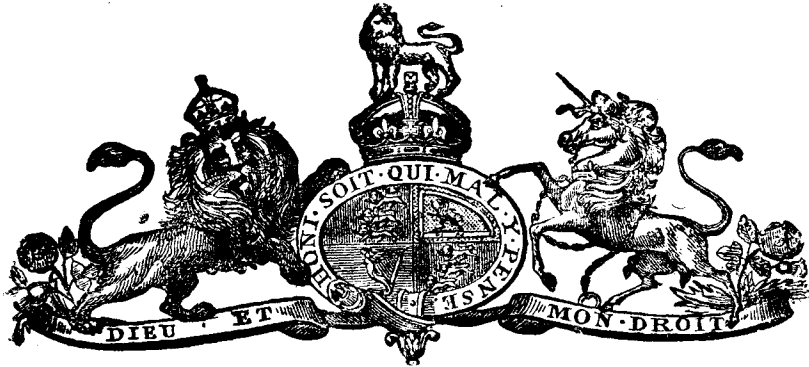

1. Short title and incorporation.
2. Amendment of Sections 5 and 10 of Principal Act.



AN ACT to amend "The State Savings Bank Transfer Act, 1912." [5 December, 1913.] ^{A.D.} 1913. —

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The State Savings Bank Transfer Amendment Act, 1913," and shall be incorporated and read as one with "The State Savings Bank Transfer Act, 1912," in this Act referred to as the Principal Act. Short title and incorporation with 3 Geo. V. No. 48.

2—(1) The Principal Act is hereby amended as follows:— Amendment of Sections 5 and 10 of Principal Act.

- i. As to Section Five by omitting the words "Seven hundred and eighty-four thousand one hundred and thirty-three Pounds," and substituting therefor the words "Eight

hundred and twelve thousand three hundred and thirty-three Pounds ; and the same or a proper proportion thereof shall be issued ” :

ii. As to Section Ten by omitting from the Fifth line the words “ or stock.”

(2) The Principal Act shall be read and construed as if the foregoing amendments thereof had been made at the commencement of the Principal Act.
