

AN ACT to authorise the Appropriation of A.D. 1889. a certain Sum for effecting Improvements in the River Tamar. [5 December, 1889.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided £10,000 to be by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to "The Launceston payable for Marine Record" any sum or sums of manay not avending in the whole Improvements in Marine Board' any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Ten thousand Pounds (£10,000), in and towards the Dredging and other Improvements in the River Tamar at Launceston.

2 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided £1000 to be by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to "The Launceston Marine Board" any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of One thousand Pounds (£1000), in and towards Improvements at Whirlpool Rock. ments in the River Tamar at Whirlpool Rock.

### Improvements, River Tamar.

#### A.D. 1889.

No moneys paid unless particulars, &c. of proposed works furnished to Minister.

Treasurer to pay money upon certificate of Engineer-in-Chief.

- 3 No moneys shall be payable under this Act unless the said Marine Board shall submit to the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being such particulars, estimates, plans, and specifications of the Works proposed to be performed as the Minister deems necessary, and the Governor in Council shall approve of the same.
- 4 Upon the receipt by the said Treasurer from time to time of a certificate by the Engineer-in-Chief that any such Works or any part thereof have been well and properly performed, and stating the total sum of the same, there shall be payable to the said Board under this Act such sum or sums of money as the Governor in Council may approve, not exceeding in the whole the said sums of Ten thousand Pounds (£10,000) and One thousand Pounds (£1000) respectively.

Short title.

5 This Act may be cited as "The Tamar Improvements Act, 1889."
