AN ACT to authorise the Appropriation of A.D. 1889.  
a certain Sum for effecting Improvements  
in the River *Tamar*. [5 December, 1889.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to "The *Launceston Marine Board*" any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Ten thousand Pounds (£10,000), in and towards the Dredging and other Improvements in the River *Tamar* at *Launceston*. £10,000 to be payable for Improvements in *Tamar*.

2 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose, to advance and pay to "The *Launceston Marine Board*" any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of One thousand Pounds (£1000), in and towards Improvements in the River *Tamar* at *Whirlpool Rock*. £1000 to be payable for Improvements at *Whirlpool Rock*.

**3** No moneys shall be payable under this Act unless the said Marine Board shall submit to the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being such particulars, estimates, plans, and specifications of the Works proposed to be performed as the Minister deems necessary, and the Governor in Council shall approve of the same.

**4** Upon the receipt by the said Treasurer from time to time of a certificate by the Engineer-in-Chief that any such Works or any part thereof have been well and properly performed, and stating the total sum of the same, there shall be payable to the said Board under this Act such sum or sums of money as the Governor in Council may approve, not exceeding in the whole the said sums of Ten thousand Pounds (£10,000) and One thousand Pounds (£1000) respectively.

**5** This Act may be cited as "The *Tamar* Improvements Act, 1889."
