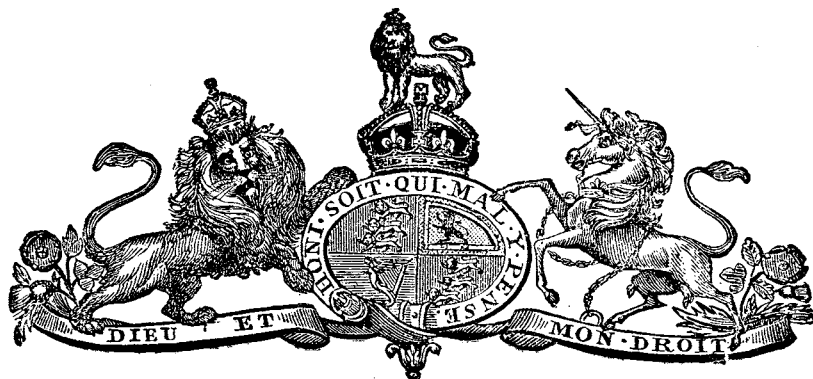

AN ACT to amend the Tamar Improvement Act, 1912. [29 October, 1930.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Tamar Improvement Act, 1930.” Short title.

**2** The Tamar Rate determined by the Board in respect of the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty is hereby declared to have been lawfully made and levied, and the same shall be payable and recoverable as provided by the Tamar Improvement Act, 1912.

**3** Upon the commencement of this Act, the Board shall determine the Tamar Rate for the period from the first day of January to the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, in lieu of such rate for the financial year ending on the last-mentioned day, and shall cause notice thereof to be gazetted as provided by the Tamar Improvement Act, 1912, and the same shall be payable and recoverable as therein provided.
