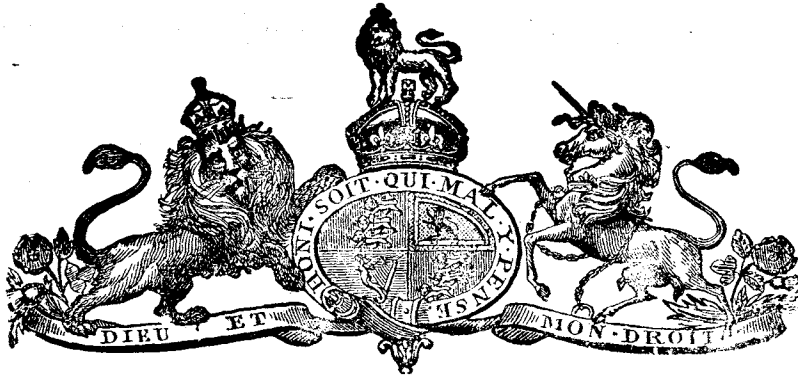

AN ACT to amend "The Tamar Improvement Act, 1912." A.D. 1913.
[24 December, 1913.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Tamar Improvement Act, 1912." PREAMBLE.
3 Geo. V. No. 52.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Tamar Improvement Act, No. 2," and shall be read as one with "The Tamar Improvement Act, 1912," which is hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act. Short title.

2 Whenever the Board desires to purchase and take any lands, which are situate between the River Tamar and a line distant One hundred Acquisition of foreshore,

feet from high water mark, the Board is hereby authorised and empowered to purchase and take the same, and for the purpose of facilitating the purchase and taking of such lands, "The Lands Clauses Act," except as expressly varied by Section Eight of the Principal Act, shall be incorporated herewith and form part hereof in manner expressed in the said Section Eight of the Principal Act.

3 The following paragraph is hereby added at the end of and as part of Section Four of the Principal Act:—

XII To manufacture cement, and for that purpose to instal such plant as may be thought necessary or advisable by the Board, and from time to time to obtain and purchase all such chalk, clay, lime, limestone, carbonate of lime, and other materials, and to use, sell, and dispose of the same and the cement made therefrom, for such purposes and to such persons as the Board shall from time to time determine :

Carbide.

XIII. To manufacture calcium carbide, and for that purpose to instal such plant as may be thought necessary or advisable by the Board, and from time to time to obtain and purchase all such lime, limestone, coke, coal, and other materials, and to use, sell, and dispose of the same, and the calcium carbide made therefrom, for such purposes and to such persons as the Board shall from time to time determine.
