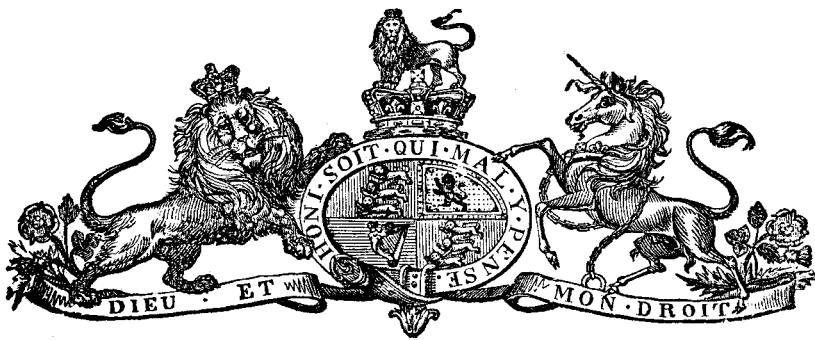

AN ACT to amend *The Tasmanian Steam Navigation Company's Act.* [11 October, 1867.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to alter and amend *The Tasmanian Steam Navigation Company's Act*: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PREAMBLE.
16 Vict. No. 1.

1 From and after the passing of this Act the Members of the said Company, together with such other persons as may from time to time become Members of the said Company, shall be a Body Corporate by the name of "*The Tasmanian Steam Navigation Company*," having a perpetual succession, and a Common Seal, with power to hold lands.

Company to be a Body Corporate.

2 From and after the passing of this Act the said Company shall sue and be sued in its corporate name: Provided that the liability of, and the proceedings against, the Members of the said Company, in case of any judgment or decree against it in its corporate name, shall be the same as in the case of any judgment or decree against a Public Officer of the said Company under the said Act.

Company to sue in its corporate name.

3 The business of the said Company shall consist in the conveying of passengers and goods by Steam Vessels between such ports and places as may, from time to time, be agreed upon by the majority of the Members of the said Company at any General Meeting.

Business of Company.

4 All real and personal estate of the said Company, whether the same be now vested in Trustees for the said Company or otherwise, and

all rights and liabilities of the said Company, shall be and the same are hereby vested in and transferred to the said Company as a Body Corporate.

Returns how made.

5 From and after the passing of this Act it shall not be necessary for the said Company to appoint any Public Officer, or to insert the name of any Public Officer in any Return by the said Act required to be made; and every such Return shall be made under the Seal of the said Company, and shall be verified by the oath of the Manager of the said Company; and, save as is by this Act provided, all acts and things which might have been done by the Public Officers of the said Company under the said Act shall hereafter be done by and in the name of the said Company.

A Member may hold more than 100 Shares.

6 Any Member of the said Company may hold more than One hundred Shares in the Capital thereof, and may receive dividends on such Shares.

Notice of Meetings how given.

7 It shall not be necessary, in giving Notice of any General Meeting of the said Company, to insert such Notice in more Newspapers than one published in *Hobart Town* and one published in *Launceston*, and in the *Gazette*.

Repeal.

8 Sections 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 16, 17, 18, 19, and 20 of *The Tasmanian Steam Navigation Company's Act* are hereby repealed.

Acts to be read together.
16 Vict. No. 1.

9 This Act and *The Tasmanian Steam Navigation Company's Act*, save so far as the same is hereby altered or repealed, shall be read and construed together as one Act.

Short Title.

10 In referring to this Act it shall be sufficient to use the expression *The Tasmanian Steam Navigation Company's Act, No. 2*.
