

ACT to further amend "The Tasmanian A.D. 1884. Steam Navigation Company's Act." [24 November, 1884.]

WHEREAS it is expedient for the well-being of the Tasmanian PREAMBLE. Steam Navigation Company to confer on the Directors of the said Company powers to raise by way of Debentures any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Fifty thousand Pounds:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Tasmanian Steam Navigation Short title. Company's Act, No. 4."

2 The Directors for the time being of the said Company, or any Five Debentures not of them, may from time to time issue Debentures for sums of money exceeding not exceeding in the whole at any one time the sum of Fifty thousand 250,000 may be issued.

Pounds, and such Debentures shall be in the form set forth in the Schedule to this Act, and shall be signed by Two Directors and the Manager of the said Company, and the Seal of the said Company shall be affixed thereto be affixed thereto.

Coupons shall be annexed to the said Debentures, and shall be in the form set forth in the said Schedule, and shall be signed by the Manager of the said Company.

3 The Company, if it repays the whole or any part of any sum of Reborrowing. money borrowed on Debentures, under the powers granted in that behalf by this Act, may again raise the whole or a portion of the

amount paid off, and so from time to time; but the power to reborrow shall not be exercised without the authority of an Annual Meeting or a Half-yearly Meeting or a Special General Meeting of the Company.

Terms upon which Debentures may be issued.

4 The said Debentures may respectively be issued for such sums not being less than One hundred Pounds each, and payable at such times and places, and at such rates of interest, and upon such terms and conditions, as the said Directors, or any Five of them, may deem expedient.

Debentures may be sold by Directors.

5 The said Directors, or any Five of them, may, at such times, on such conditions, and in such manner as they may think expedient, offer or cause to be offered for sale the said Debentures or any of them, either by public tender, or by public auction, or by private contract.

Acts to be read together.

6 This Act and "The *Tasmanian* Steam Navigation Company's Act," and every Act amending the same, shall be read and construed together as one Act.
