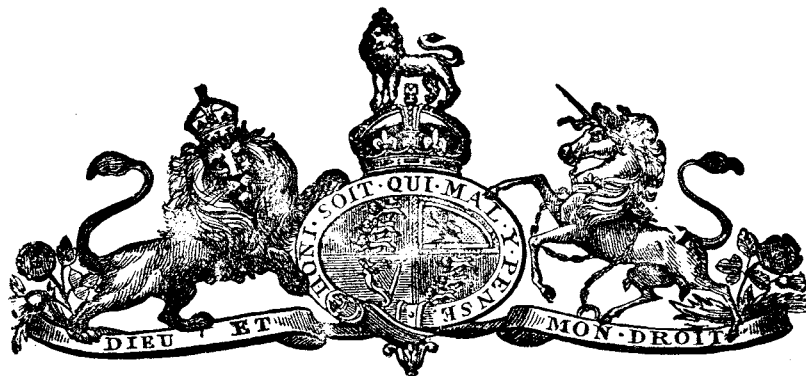

AN ACT to further amend "The Tasmanian University Act." [5 December, 1913.]

A.D. 1913.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Tasmanian University Amendment Act, 1913," and shall be construed as one with "The Tasmanian University Act" and every Act amending the same.

Short title and incorporation with 53 Vict. No. 41.

2 Section Two of "The Tasmanian University Act"—as re-enacted by Section Three of "The Tasmanian University Amendment Act, 1890"—is hereby amended—

Amendment of Section 2 of 53 Vict. No. 41.

- i. By omitting the word "Eighteen" from the First line thereof, and substituting therefor the word "Nineteen":
- ii. By inserting at the end thereof the words "and the Director of Education for the time being also shall *ex officio* be a member of the Council."

Director of Education to be *ex officio* member of Council.
