AN ACT for adapting and assimilating the A.D. 1888.
Trusts of Wesleyan Church Properties to
the present Constitution of such Church
in *Tasmania*, and for other collateral
purposes. [2 July, 1888.]

WHEREAS by an Indenture of Release bearing date the Thirtieth day of *June*, One thousand eight hundred and forty, and made or expressed to be made between the Reverend *Nathaniel Turner*, therein described of the first part, and the Reverend *John Waterhouse, John Dunn, Esh Lovell, John Hiddlestone, David Lord, John Barrett, William Watchorn, Thomas James Crouch, John Sherwin the elder, Alexander Christie Lowe, Alexander Fraser, Henry Stevenson Hurst, William Warham, Charles Williams, and John Surtees White*, all therein respectively described of the second part, and duly registered in the Office of the Registrar of Deeds at *Hobart*, in *Tasmania*, on the Twenty-third day of *July* in the year last aforesaid, the number of the Memorial being $\frac{2}{3695}$, the hereditaments and premises therein comprised were thereby conveyed (*inter alia*) upon trust to permit such persons only to preach and perform the usual acts of religious worship therein as should be duly appointed by or under the authority of the *English Conference*; and such Model Deed is hereinafter referred to as the "*Old Tasmanian Wesleyan Model Deed*:"

And whereas most of the church lands in *Tasmania* have been conveyed or settled upon the trusts of such "*Old Tasmanian Wesleyan Model Deed*," as to those not under the operation of *The Real Property*

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Act, by means of conveyances referring to such trusts, and as to those under the operation of such Act by the Trustees as the registered proprietors thereof executing separate declarations of trusts :

And whereas the religious society in *Tasmania* denominated Wesleyan Methodists, (hereinafter called the Wesleyan Methodist Church in *Tasmania*) has always formed an integral portion of the *Australasian* Wesleyan Methodist Church as constituted from time to time by the *English* Conference :

New Constitution.

And whereas such *Australasian* Wesleyan Methodist Church has now a separate and independent constitution, approved of and adopted by the said *English* Conference ; and it is now divided into four Annual Conferences respectively, called "The *New South Wales* and *Queensland* Conference," "The *Victoria* and *Tasmania* Conference," "The *South Australian* Conference," and "The *New Zealand* Conference," such Annual Conferences being comprised in and governed by a General Conference assembling once every three years, or at such other intervals, more or less, as it may deem expedient ; such Annual Conference having among other things the power of appointing its own ministers—a copy of which Constitution, and also a copy of the Deed Poll of *John Wesley*, hereinafter referred to, are set forth in the Schedule to "The Wesleyan Methodist Model Deed of *Tasmania*, 1888," also hereinafter mentioned :

And whereas under the authority of the said General Conference, and by and with the sanction and approval of the *English* Conference, a new Model Deed has been prepared and adopted by the *Victoria* and *Tasmania* Conference containing trusts and provisions adapted and assimilated to the present constitution of the Wesleyan Methodist Church in *Tasmania*, to the end and intent that all lands belonging to or held on behalf of such church may hereafter be held upon such trusts and provisions, and discharged from all previous trusts ; and the said *Victoria* and *Tasmania* Conference has also been duly invested by the said General Conference, with the approval of the *English* Conference, with full authority to obtain an Act of the Legislature of *Tasmania* for the purposes hereinafter set forth :

And whereas such new Model Deed bears date the eighteenth day of *May*, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight, and is made or expressed to be made between *Basil Archer* and *Robert Dugald Stewart* therein described of the first part, the Reverend *John Gane Millard*, the Reverend *John Cope*, the Reverend *Henry Greenwood*, the Reverend *George Thomas Heyward*, the Reverend *Spencer Williams*, the Reverend *David Stewart Lindsay*, *David Cocker*, *Caleb Joshua Hiller*, the Honorable *John Hair McCall*, *Frederick Hart*, the said *Basil Archer*, and *Robert Dugald Stewart*, the Honorable *William Hart*, *Charles Beaumont Barnes Grubb*, *Thomas Parramore*, *Edward Hawson*, *William Micah Williams*, and *Thomas James Crouch*, all therein described and thereafter throughout called the said Trustees, of the second part, and *Samuel Percy Crisp* therein described of the third part ; and such Model Deed has been duly executed, attested, and registered in the Office of the said Registrar of Deeds, the Memorial thereof being No. $\frac{3}{9} \frac{8}{7}$, and such Deed is herein referred to as "The Wesleyan Methodist Model Deed of *Tasmania*, 1888 " :

And whereas it is necessary to obtain power for carrying some of the trusts and provisions contained in such last-mentioned deed into effect, and for establishing a Trustee Register whereby the due succession of

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Trustees for church lands may be maintained without conveyance or transfer, and for creating facilities for proof : **A.D. 1888.**

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows, (that is to say) :—

Register of Trustees, and to maintain succession of Trustees without conveyance, &c.

1 It shall be sufficient to cite this Act as “The *Tasmanian Wesleyan Methodists Act, 1888*,” and to cite “The Wesleyan Methodist Model Deed of *Tasmania, 1888*,” by that title. **Short title.**

2 In the interpretation of this Act the following terms shall have the meanings hereinafter respectively assigned to them, unless inconsistent with the subject or context :— **Interpretation.**

“*English Conference*” means the Yearly Conference of the people called Methodists in *England*, as explained in the Deed Poll of the 28th *February, 1784*, executed by *John Wesley*, and enrolled in the High Court of Chancery in *England* :

The term “*Church lands*” includes all lands and premises in *Tasmania*, of whatever tenure, and chattels real, which now are, or which may at any time hereafter be, held in trust for or on behalf of the Wesleyan Methodist Church in *Tasmania*, together with all churches or chapels, dwelling-houses, schools, and all other buildings thereon ; and also all fittings, fixtures, rights, easements, and appurtenances whatever relating thereto respectively, or therewith usually held and enjoyed :

“*Authorised Representative*” of the Wesleyan Methodist Church of *Tasmania* means such person as may be, for the time being, appointed in that capacity by the *Victoria and Tasmania Conference*, and approved by the Governor in Council : and “*Acting Authorised Representative*” means such person as may be appointed to such office by the President for the time being of the *Victoria and Tasmania Conference*, with the approval of the Governor in Council :

The words “*legal proceedings*” shall include all proceedings whatever, whether preliminary, initiatory, interlocutory, or final, in any Court of Justice, or before the Recorder of Titles :

“*Victoria and Tasmania Conference*” means the Annual Conference of the *Australasian Wesleyan Methodist Church* for the time being, embracing within its jurisdiction the Colony of *Tasmania*, whether alone or combined as at present with another Colony, such Annual Conference being duly constituted by the General Conference, and forming an integral part thereof.

3 The Registrar of the Supreme Court of *Tasmania* is hereby empowered and directed to enrol in the proper office “The Wesleyan Methodist Model Deed of *Tasmania, 1888*,” hereinbefore referred to, when such deed is presented or tendered to him for that purpose by or on behalf of the President for the time being of the *Victoria and Tasmania Conference*. **Enrolment of Model Deed.**

4 All church lands, including those specified in Schedule (1) hereto, held immediately before the commencement of this Act upon the trusts of “The Old *Tasmanian Wesleyan Model Deed*,” or upon any other **How present and future church lands to be held. Schedule (1.)**

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trusts, or which may at any time or times hereafter be acquired by gift, purchase, devise, bequest, or otherwise, shall, after the coming into operation of this Act, subject and without prejudice to any mortgage, charge, encumbrance, lien, or lease affecting the same respectively, be held upon the trusts, and subject to the provisions of "The Wesleyan Methodist Model Deed of *Tasmania*, 1888," or any future alteration or modification thereof duly authorised by the said *Victoria* and *Tasmania* Conference, by and with the approval of the said General Conference, and upon and subject to no other trusts or provisions whatever: Provided always that nothing in this Section shall extend to lands belonging to any Wesleyan Methodist College.

5 Where any sale, mortgage, exchange, or lease of any church land held upon the trusts of "The Wesleyan Methodist Model Deed of *Tasmania*, 1888," shall be made in pursuance of, and in conformity with, such trusts, the transfer, mortgage, exchange, or lease of such land, if under the operation of "The Real Property Act," shall be as effectual if signed by a majority of the Trustees for the time being of such land named in the "Register of Trustees" hereinafter mentioned, as if such transfer, mortgage, exchange, or lease had been duly signed by all the Trustees so named; and in case such land shall not be under the operation of such Act, the conveyance, mortgage, exchange, or lease thereof, if executed by a majority of the Trustees for the time being thereof named in such "Register of Trustees," shall be deemed to pass the legal estate therein as fully and effectually as if all the Trustees in whom the legal estate was vested had joined in, executed, or made such conveyance, mortgage, exchange, or lease: Provided always that the Trustees making any such transfer, conveyance, mortgage, exchange, or lease shall consist of not less than Three in number: Provided also that any Trustee absent from the Colony may join in any contract for sale, mortgage, exchange, or lease, and execute any such conveyance, transfer, mortgage, exchange, or lease as aforesaid by his attorney duly appointed by him in that behalf under seal.

6 The Authorised Representative for the time being of the Wesleyan Methodist Church in *Tasmania*, or the Acting Authorised Representative thereof for the time being, shall keep or cause to be kept a "Register of Trustees" of all church lands, and such Register shall be called and inscribed as "The Wesleyan Methodist Church Register of Trustees for *Tasmania*," and shall be in the form or to the effect contained in Schedule (2.) hereto; and such Authorised Representative or Acting Authorised Representative shall with all reasonable despatch enter or cause to be entered in such "Register of Trustees" the names and additions of the Trustees for the time being of such church lands, with all other particulars indicated by the said Schedule (2.); and such Authorised Representative or Acting Authorised Representative shall from time to time, upon the due appointment of any new Trustee or Trustees of any church lands, insert or cause to be inserted in such "Register of Trustees" the name and addition of such new Trustee or Trustees, the date of the appointment of the new Trustee or Trustees, and also the date of the insertion of his or their name or names in such "Register of Trustees," and how the vacancy in the Trust occurred, whether by death or otherwise; and such Authorised Representative or Acting Authorised Representative shall sign his name in such "Register of Trustees" in the proper column in the

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same line with the name of every trustee (old and new) to authenticate the due appointment of each Trustee. And such Authorised Representative or Acting Authorised Representative may at any time or times issue a certificate in the form or to the effect in Schedule (3.) hereto under his hand stating who is or are the Trustee or Trustees of any particular church lands specified therein at the date of such certificate, or who was or were such Trustee or Trustees at any particular date specified in such certificate; and such "Register of Trustees" shall on all reasonable occasions be open to the inspection of the members of the said church and all others interested therein.

7 The Authorised Representative or Acting Authorised Representative shall have full power at any time to amend the "Register of Trustees," by rectifying any error or supplying any omission therein, and shall initial such amendment and affix thereto the date the same was made, but shall not erase or render illegible the part so rectified; and the Register so amended shall have all the validity and operation by this Act conferred upon the "Register of Trustees."

8 On the insertion and authentication as aforesaid in the said "Register of Trustees" of the name or names of any new Trustee or Trustees of any church lands not under the operation of *The Real Property Act*, such church lands shall forthwith vest in such new Trustee or Trustees, solely or jointly, as the case may be, with the continuing Trustee or Trustees (if any) for all the estate and interest of the former Trustee or Trustees therein, and upon and subject to the same Trust, without any conveyance or assignment whatsoever, and on the insertion and authentication as aforesaid in the said "Register of Trustees" of the name or names of any new Trustee or Trustees of church lands under the operation of the said Act, such new Trustee or Trustees, together with the continuing Trustees (if any) shall for all purposes be taken to be the Trustee or Trustees for the time being thereof; and the Trustee or Trustees for the time being appearing by the "Register of Trustees" to be the Trustee or Trustees of any church lands under *The Real Property Act* shall be entitled to be registered as the proprietor or proprietors thereof within the meaning of such Act without any formal transfer, and to have a certificate of title issued to him or them, or in his or their name or names, as such proprietor or proprietors, but subject to any then subsisting encumbrance appearing upon the Register Book affecting the same.

9 The entries in the "Register of Trustees" authorised by Section Five of this Act to be made therein, when authenticated by the signature of the Authorised Representative or Acting Authorised Representative, and any certificate duly signed by the Authorised Representative or Acting Authorised Representative under the provisions hereof, shall respectively be received in evidence in all legal proceedings and on all occasions whatsoever as *prima facie* evidence of all the matters contained or recited in such entries when the "Register of Trustees" is produced, and of all matters contained or recited in such certificate when such certificate is produced.

10 In case of the decease, illness, absence from the Colony of *Tasmania*, or temporary incapacity of the Authorised Representative, or of any Acting Authorised Representative under this Section, some

other person may, as hereinbefore mentioned, be appointed to act in his place, but for not a longer period than the due appointment of an Authorised Representative, at the then next Annual Meeting of the *Victoria* and *Tasmania* Conference, and such other person shall be designated the Acting Authorised Representative of the said church, and such Acting Authorised Representative during the continuance of his appointment shall have, perform, and execute all the powers, authorities, and duties of such Authorised Representative, and shall, underneath his signature in the said "Register of Trustees," or affixed to any certificate given by him under the provisions hereof, write "Acting Authorised Representative;" and the *Hobart Gazette* containing a notification of the approval of the Governor in Council of the appointment of such Authorised Representative, or of such Acting Authorised Representative as aforesaid, shall be sufficient evidence of the due appointment of such Authorised Representative and Acting Authorised Representative respectively, and of the approval thereof by the Governor in Council.

11 A document purporting to be a printed copy of the printed Minutes of the *English* Conference, or of the said General Conference or of any of the four said Annual Conferences constituted by such General Conference, or of any Annual Conferences which may at any time hereafter be duly constituted by the said General Conference respectively, shall, if certified under the hand of such Authorised Representative, or Acting Authorised Representative as aforesaid, be taken and received in all legal proceedings and on all occasions whatsoever as *primâ facie* evidence of all resolutions and orders touching or concerning all elections or expulsions, consents, disbursements, delegations, appointments, and of all acts and proceedings whatsoever of such *English* Conference, General Conference, or Annual Conference respectively, without the aid of any further proof whatever; and a document purporting to be a printed copy of "The Wesleyan Methodist Model Deed of *Tasmania*, 1888," and of the Schedule thereto attached, shall, if certified under the hand of such Authorised Representative, or Acting Authorised Representative as aforesaid, also be received and taken in all legal proceedings and on all occasions whatsoever as *primâ facie* evidence of such Deed, and of the Constitution of the said General Conference, and of the four said Annual Conferences, and of the aforesaid Deed Poll of *John Wesley*, without the production of the originals thereof respectively; and a document purporting to be a copy of the "Old *Tasmanian* Wesleyan Model Deed" shall, if certified under the hand of such Authorised Representative or Acting Authorised Representative in like manner, be received as *primâ facie* evidence of such Deed, without the production of the original Deed.

The first column shows the locality in which the Church lands are situate; the second column shows the nature of the title, whether Crown Grant, Certificate of Title, Conveyance, or otherwise; and the third column shows, in cases of Crown Grants and Certificates of Titles respectively, the date of enrolment or the volume and folio in the Register Book in the office of the Registrar of the Supreme Court of *Tasmania* or the Recorder of Titles, as the case may be; and in cases of Conveyance registered in the office of the Registrar of Deeds, such third column shows the date of Registration and Number of each Memorial: which Crown Grants, Certificates of Title, and Memorials of Conveyances respectively contain a description of the lands respectively therein comprised.
