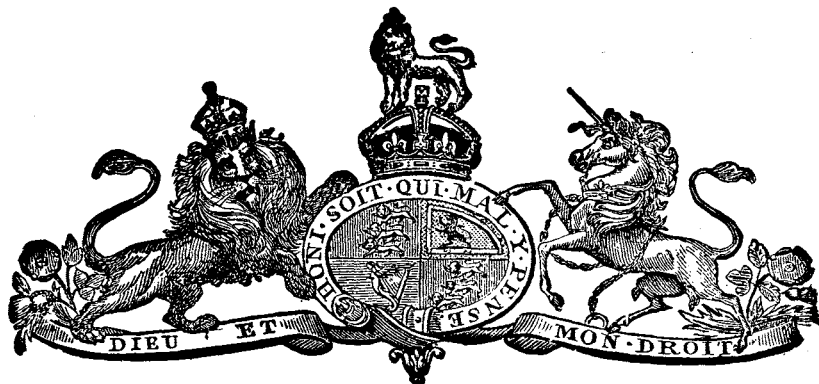

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as “The Unclaimed Moneys Act, 1927.” Short title.

(2) The Unclaimed Moneys Act, 1918, is herein called “the Principal Act.” Principal Act.

2 Subsection (1) of Section Six of the Principal Act is hereby repealed and the following subsection substituted therefor:—

“(1) Within fourteen days after the expiration of one year from the publication of any such copy register, as aforesaid, the company shall deliver to the Treasurer a return in the form set forth in Schedule (3)

to this Act, setting out the particulars of the unclaimed moneys referred to in such copy register, and indicating which (if any) of the said moneys have been paid by the company to the owners thereof since such publication as aforesaid and the company shall, at the time of the delivery of the said return, pay to the Treasurer for the use of the Consolidated Revenue such of the unclaimed moneys so referred to as aforesaid as have not been so paid to the owners thereof as aforesaid. Such return as aforesaid shall be verified by statutory declaration appended thereto, to be made by an officer of the company, and to be in the form set forth in the said Schedule (3)."
