

AN ACT to provide for the Relief of Unemployment in certain cases and to appropriate a Sum of Twenty thousand Pounds from the Consolidated Revenue for that purpose.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Unemployment Relief Act, 1930.” Short title.

Unemployment Relief.

2—(1) It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be paid, expended, and applied for and during the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Twenty thousand Pounds for or towards the execution of any public work approved by the Minister or in such other manner as the Minister may think best for the purpose of affording assistance to unemployed persons.

(2) In any case in which he considers that the circumstances require it, the Minister may apply any moneys at his disposal under this Act in providing sustenance for any unemployed person or to the dependants of any such person.

3—(1) Out of the said sum of Twenty thousand Pounds the Minister shall allocate and apply such sum not exceeding Five thousand Pounds as may be prescribed for the purpose of assisting primary producers in relieving unemployment by providing work for unemployed persons in carrying out permanent improvements to or upon the holdings of such primary producers.

(2) The application of any moneys so allocated shall be administered by such persons, in such manner and subject to such conditions as may be prescribed.

Appropriation.

4 All moneys required for the purposes of this Act shall be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue which, to the necessary extent, is hereby appropriated accordingly.

Regulations.

5—(1) The Governor may make regulations under and for the purposes of this Act prescribing all matters and things which may be necessary or convenient for giving effect to the provisions thereof.

(2) Any such regulation may prescribe a penalty not exceeding Ten Pounds for the breach of any regulation so made.
