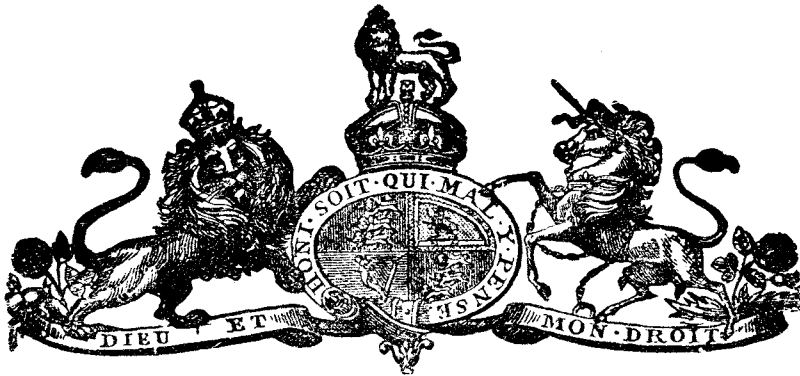

AN ACT to amend the Unemployed (Assistance to Primary Producers) Relief Act, 1930. [4 November, 1931.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Unemployed (Assistance to Primary Producers) Relief Act, 1931.”

2 The Unemployment (Assistance to Primary Producers) Relief Act, 1930, is hereby amended—

I. By deleting the words "ten days" in the third line of Subsection (2) of Section Three thereof and substituting therefor the words "one month" and by adding at the end of the said subsection the words "but the Board, if in its opinion the circumstances justify its so doing, may declare a person to be eligible although his name has not been recorded as aforesaid." :

II. By deleting the words "ten years" in the third line of Subsection (7) of Section Three thereof and substituting therefor the words "eleven years and six months" :

III. By inserting after Subsection (8) of Section Three thereof the following new Subsection (9)—

"(9) Where any such advance as aforesaid is made for the purpose of erecting, repairing, or altering any building, interest shall be payable by the borrower in respect thereof at the rate of Two Pounds Ten Shillings per centum per annum." :

IV. By repealing Section Four thereof and substituting therefor the following new Section Four—

"**4**—(1) Where the Board is satisfied that—

- i. Any person who is the holder of any agricultural land is eligible for employment as provided by Subsection (2) of Section Three hereof :
- ii. Such person is unemployed by reason of the fact that such land, in the opinion of the Board, is not sufficiently developed or improved to provide such person with adequate support during the full year :
- iii. The proposed development or improvement of such land will have the effect of so increasing its productivity as to make it capable of providing such support as aforesaid :
- iv. Such person, in the opinion of the Board, is a fit and proper person for relief under this section : and
- v. Such person has applied in good faith for such relief—

the Board, in its discretion, may make an advance to such person, as provided by Section Three hereof, for the purpose of effecting permanent improvements approved by the Board upon such land, and, subject to the approval of the Board, any work performed by such person shall be deemed to constitute the employment by him of an eligible person within the meaning of that section.

Unemployed (Assistance to Primary Producers) Relief.

(2) Where the Board is satisfied that any person to whom an advance has been made under this Act desires in good faith to dispose of the property in respect of which such advance was made, the Board, subject to such conditions as it may think necessary, may permit the transfer of the liability for such advance to some other person and may discharge the person to whom such advance was made from such liability or any part thereof. :

(3) Any advance under this Act may be made in such manner as may be prescribed."

- V. By deleting the words "not later than the thirtieth day of Section 5. November, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one" in the second and third lines of Subsection (2) of Section Five thereof : and
- VI. By deleting the words "to be provided by Parliament for that purpose" in the second and third lines of Section Twelve thereof and substituting therefor the words "raised and borrowed for the purposes of this Act."
