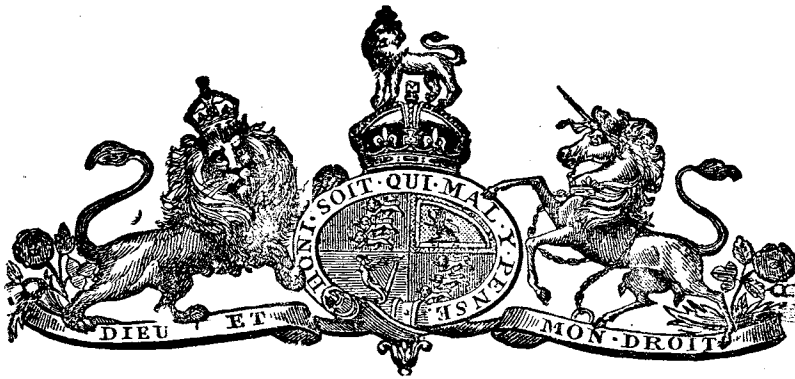

AN ACT to amend an Act to make provision
for a Supply of Pure Water for the Town

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as “The *Ulverstone* Water Act Amendment Act, 1907.” Short title.

3 It shall be lawful for the trustees, without taking any of the proceedings directed in Sections Eighty-eight, Eighty-nine, and Ninety of the said Act, to borrow (in addition to the sum of Nine thousand Pounds authorised to be borrowed by the said Act) the sum of One thousand Pounds for the purposes of the said Act; and it shall be lawful for the Governor from time to time to grant to the trustees as a loan or loans for the purposes of the said Act, under the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," any sum or sums of money not exceeding One thousand Pounds.

4 It shall not be necessary to lay before either House of the Parliament of *Tasmania* plans and specifications of the proposed works, or a report of the Engineer-in-Chief upon any of the matters mentioned in Section Two of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," notwithstanding anything to the contrary in that Act contained.
