**2** Section Three of the Principal Act is hereby repealed, and the following section substituted therefor :—

**3** If the amount of wages of any such person exceeds the rate of Two Pounds per week, whether payable at a yearly, monthly, weekly, or daily rate, or by the piece, or at a fixed price, or otherwise howsoever, any surplus above that rate per week shall be liable to attachment as before the commencement of this Act, and not otherwise: Provided always that it shall be competent for the Court, Judge, or Justice to order that the whole or any part of such wages as may be attached be paid over to the judgment debtor upon taking into consideration the circumstances and means of the judgment debtor and of his family, as may seem just to such Court, Judge, or Justice.”
