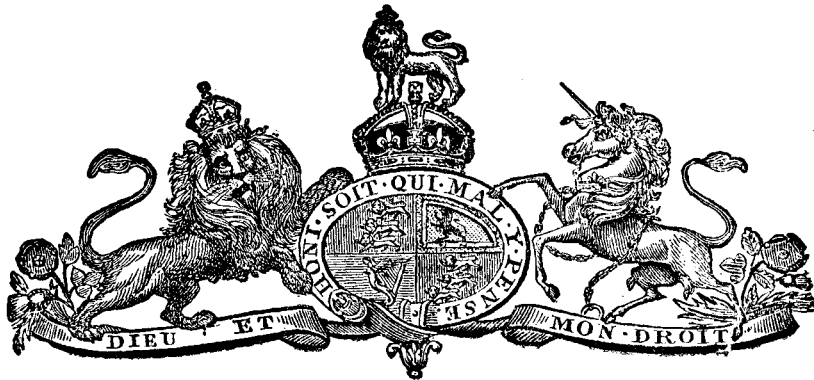

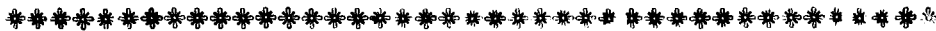

AN ACT to amend the Westbury and Hagley Water Supply Act, 1898, and to authorise a further Loan of Three thousand five hundred Pounds to the Corporation of the Municipality of Westbury for the purposes of that Act. [18 January, 1930.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as “The Westbury and Hagley Water Act, 1929.”
- (2) The Westbury and Hagley Water Act, 1898, is herein called “the Principal Act.”

Interpretation.

**2** In this Act—

“The Council” means the Council of the Municipality:

“The Corporation” means the Warden, councillors, and electors of the Municipality of Westbury.

Council may borrow £3500.

**3** It shall be lawful for the Council, on behalf of the Corporation, in addition to any moneys already borrowed under the Principal Act, to borrow, under the provisions of the State Loans to Local Bodies Act, 1929, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Three thousand five hundred Pounds for the purposes of the Principal Act and of defraying the costs and expenses of and incidental to the preparation and passing of this Act.

Sinking fund.

**4** The sum payable by the Council as an annual contribution towards a sinking fund in respect of any moneys borrowed under this Act shall be an amount equal to Two Pounds per centum of the moneys so borrowed.

Rate of interest.

**5** The interest payable in respect of any loan granted under this Act shall be at the annual rate of Five Pounds Fifteen Shillings per centum on the amount of such loan.

Treasurer may borrow £3500.

**6** It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to borrow, raise, and receive a total sum not exceeding Three thousand five hundred Pounds for the purpose of this Act.

Repeal of Section 47 of 62 Vict. No. 64 and substitution of new section.

**7** The Principal Act is hereby amended by repealing Section Forty-seven thereof and substituting therefor the following new Section Forty-seven:—

“**47**—(1) The Council may make and levy Water Rates upon the annual value of all properties within the Water District as shown by the assessment roll in force for the time being.

(2) Such rates shall not exceed in respect of any one year the sum of Three Shillings and Six Pence in the pound upon such annual value as aforesaid, except as provided by Subsection (3) hereof.

(3) The rate or the aggregate of the rates, as the case may be, levied in respect of any house or dwelling within the Water District shall in no case be less than Twelve Shillings per annum.”
