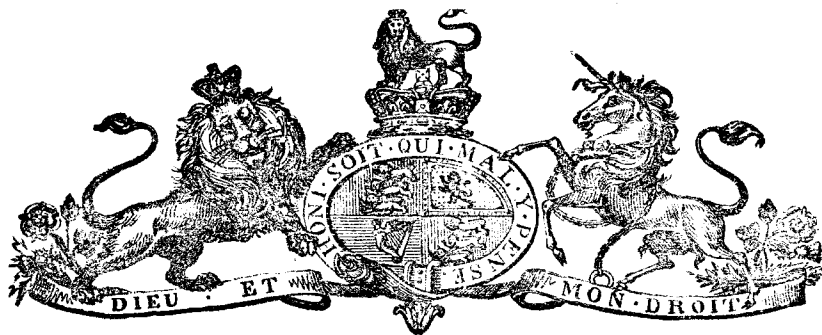

AN ACT to further amend "The *Westbury* A.D. 1900,
and *Hagley* Water Act, 1898."
[6 December, 1900.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and 62 Vict. No. 64,
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of
Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The *Westbury* and *Hagley* Water Amendment Act, 1900." Short title.

2 In this Act, the expression "the said Act" shall mean "The *Westbury* and *Hagley* Water Amendment Act, 1899." Interpretation.

3 The words "Three thousand five hundred" in the second and third lines of Section Four of the said Act, and in the twelfth line of the same Section of the said Act, are hereby expunged, and in lieu thereof the words "Four thousand" are hereby respectively inserted in the said Section of the said Act. 4 This Act and "The *Westbury* and *Hagley* Water Act, 1898," and the said Act, save as amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act. Acts to be read
