AN ACT to provide for the Application of 1933. the Moneys Granted by the Commonwealth to this State for the purpose of affording Relief to Wheat Growers.

[10 January, 1934.]

WHEREAS by the Wheat Growers Relief Act, 1933, of the PREAMBLE. Commonwealth it is enacted that the sum of Four thousand and twenty-four Pounds shall be granted by the Commonwealth by way of financial assistance to this State, and that that sum shall be so granted upon the condition that it is applied by the State for the assistance of wheat growers as provided by the Commonwealth Act:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House

of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Wheat Growers Relief Act, 1933." Short title.

2 In this Act—

Interpretation.

"Director" means the Director of Agriculture:

- "The Commonwealth Act" means the Wheat Growers Relief Act 1933 of the Commonwealth:
- "The Suspense Account" means the account kept pursuant to Section Three:
- "Wheat grower" means any person who has sown wheat during the year 1933.

Wheat Growers Relief Suspense Account.

- 3-(1) Upon the commencement of this Act, there shall be opened and kept in the books of the Treasury an account to be called "The Wheat Growers Relief Suspense Account."
- (2) There shall be paid and credited to the Suspense Account all moneys received by this State under the provisions of the Commonwealth Act.

Application of moneys.

4 The amount standing to the credit of the Suspense Account shall be paid and applied by the Treasurer as may be prescribed, upon the certificate of the Director, and in accordance with the provisions of the Commonwealth Act and the regulations thereunder.

Regulations.

5 The Governor may make regulations for the purposes of this Act.
