AN ACT to amend "The Zeehan-Western, 1909.
Limited, Deep Sinking Encouragement Act, 7 Ed. VII. No. 9.
1907." [22 December, 1909.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

This Act may be cited as "The Zeehan-Western, Limited, Deep-Short title and Sing Amendment Act, 1909," and shall be read with "The incorporation. Ze an-Western, Limited, Deep Sinking Encouragement Act, 1907," 7 Ed. VII. No. 9. here nafter referred to as "the said Act."

Zeehan-Western, Limited, Amendment.

A.D. 1909.

Repeal and re-enactment of Section 4 of the said Act.

Moneys advanced to be a charge on profits arising from mine and property.

- 2—(1.) Section Four of the said Act is hereby repealed, and the following section substituted therefor, namely:—
- "4 All moneys paid to the company on account of the said grant-in-aid of Three thousand Pounds shall be and are hereby until repayment thereof charged upon the company's mine and property, notwithstanding any change in the ownership thereof, to the extent that no profits arising from the working of the said mine below the depth of Eight hundred feet shall be taken or paid away at any time until all moneys paid to the company in respect of the said sum of Three thousand Pounds shall have been repaid to the Treasurer; and the company or the owner for the time being of the said mine and property shall comply with the terms of this section, and the Treasurer may take any proceedings at law or in equity to compel compliance herewith."
- (2.) The said repeal and substitution shall take effect as from the commencement of the said Act.
