

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title. 2. Appropriation of £40,000 for unemployment relief.

AN ACT to provide out of the Consolidated Revenue a Sum of Forty thousand Pounds for the purposes of the Relief of Unem-[27 July, 1934.] ployment.

W HEREAS the Governor, on the twenty-sixth day of June, Preamble. one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, authorised the expenditure out of the Consolidated Revenue of a sum of Forty thousand Pounds for the purpose of covering emergent expenditure for the relief of unemployment, and directed that the said sum should be transferred and credited to a special account in the books of the Treasury, and applied for the purposes hereinafter mentioned, and the same has been paid to an account opened in the books of the Treasury which is called the "Winter Relief of Unemployment Suspense Account":

And whereas it is desirable to authorise and provide for the expenditure of the said sum of Forty thousand Pounds:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

2—(1) The expenditure of the said sum of Forty thousand Pounds for the purposes and in the proportions set forth in the schedule is hereby authorised, and the said sum shall be

deemed to have been appropriated therefor on the said twentysixth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four. (2) The said moneys standing to the credit of the said

suspense account shall be paid and applied by the Treasurer in the proportions and for and towards the several purposes indicated in the schedule.
