



VERMIN DESTRUCTION AMENDMENT ACT 1980

AN ACT to amend the Vermin Destruction Act 1950 with respect to the membership of the appeal board constituted under that Act.

[Royal Assent 16 September 1980]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Vermin Destruction Amendment Act 1980*. Short title.

Principal Act.

2—In this Act, the *Vermin Destruction Act 1950** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 7 of Principal Act (Appeal board).

3—(1) Section 7 (2) of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—

(a) by omitting paragraphs (a) and (b) and substituting the following paragraph:—

(a) two shall be persons nominated by the body of persons known as the Tasmanian Farmers' and Graziers' Association; and

(b) by renumbering paragraph (c) as paragraph (b).

(2) Section 7 of the Principal Act is further amended by omitting subsection (3) and substituting the following subsection:—

(3) Each of the bodies mentioned in subsection (2) shall, within 30 days after being requested by the Minister to do so, nominate a person or persons, as the case may be, for appointment to the appeal board, in default of which the Governor, without any nomination, may, on the recommendation of the Minister, appoint a person or persons as a member or members of the appeal board to represent that body.
