AN ACT to amend the Workers' Compensation Act 1927. II8 November 1948 1

RE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania. by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:--

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Workers' Compensa-Short title and citation. tion Act 1948.

- (2) The Workers' Compensation Act 1927*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

- "(3A) Without limiting the generality of the provisions of subtained by workers. subsection (1) but subject to the provisions of subsection by workers. - I. While the worker on any working day on which he has attended at his place of employment pursuant to his contract of employment is present at his place of employment: or
- II. While the worker is travelling between his place of residence or place of employment and any trade, technical, or other training school which he is required to attend by the terms of his employment or as an apprentice, or which he is expected by his employer to attend, or is in attendance at any such school.
- (3B) The provisions of paragraph II. of subsection (3A) shall not apply in respect of any injury received by a worker while travelling between any places mentioned in that subsection if the injury is received during or after—
 - I. Any substantial interruption of, or substantial deviation from, his journey, made for a reason unconnected with his employment, or unconnected with his attendance at the school, as the case may be:
 - II. Any other break in his journey which, having regard to all the circumstances, was not reasonably incidental to any such journey.".
