AN ACT to amend the Workers' (Occupational Diseases) Relief Fund Act 1954.

[14 November 1960.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title, citation, and commencement.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Workers' (Occupational Diseases) Relief Fund Act 1960.
- (2) The Workers' (Occupational Diseases) Relief Fund Act 1954, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) This Act shall commence on the date on which the Hospitals Act 1960 commences.

Interpretation. 2 Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of the definition of "nurse" in subsection (1) the words "or private hospital within the meaning of the Hospitals Act 1918" and substituting therefor the words "within the meaning of the Hospitals Act 1918 or in a private medical establishment licensed under Part III of that Act in which medical or surgical or lying-in cases are received and lodged for any treatment, attendance, or care for which a charge is made".
