AN ACT to amend the *Workers' (Occupational Diseases) Relief Fund Act 1954.*

[23 December 1957.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Workers' (Occupational Diseases) Relief Fund Act (No. 2) 1957.* Short title and citation.

(2) The *Workers' (Occupational Diseases) Relief Fund Act 1954*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section three of the Principal Act is amended—

Interpretation.

- (a) by omitting the word “or” at the end of subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of the definition of “nurse”, in subsection (1) of that section;
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) of that definition the words “Public Health” and substituting therefor the words “Health Services”; and
- (c) by adding at the end of that definition the following paragraph:—

“; or

“(c) as a nurse in—

- (i) the District Nursing Centres Division of that Department;
- (ii) the Tourist Nursing Division of that Department; or
- (iii) any other branch or division of that Department that is declared by the Minister, by order made on the recommendation of the Board, to be a nursing branch or nursing division of that Department for the purposes of this definition;”
